# Have your say on diabetes in schools

Diabetes Australia is currently leading consultation to develop a national program to better support kids with type 1 diabetes in schools.

The new nationally consistent training program for teachers and school staff will be targeted at every school with a student with type 1 diabetes and this will cover the safe administration of insulin, hypoglycemia (low blood glucose level) management, and 'normalising' diabetes in schools so the students are not stigmatised.

The program will also clarify the legal framework for diabetes management in schools and resolve any confusion over who can train school staff, and which school staff should be trained.

To ensure the new program meets the needs of schools, students and parents, and builds on all the good work already happening, we want to hear from you about what works and what needs to be improved. **Class and Individual Photos** - A Don Wood Photography order envelope is attached. There are six packages available.

There are TWO (2) methods of payment only – Credit Card online (preferred) or Cash.

- Online If you wish to pay by credit card online (Visa and Mastercard only) please go to donwoodphotography.com.au and follow the links. The school code you will need to enter is 219818.
- Cash If you wish to pay by cash please *enclose the correct money in the order envelope for each child* and return that envelope to the school on the day of our school photos.
- $\Rightarrow$  If you pay online you **do not need** to send in the order envelope to school.
- $\Rightarrow$  Please read ordering instructions on the flyer inside the photo envelope carefully.
- $\Rightarrow$  Check your order carefully as refunds are not available for incorrect package choice.

Each child must present their own completed envelope if paying by cash. If you have more than one child attending the school please ensure you complete an order envelope for each child's **cash** payment.

Family Photos – there are three packages available.

- ⇒ If you would like a photo of your children you may order a "Family Photo". Family photo order forms are available on request from the office.
- ⇒ Your order must be returned to school on the photo day Thursday, 30 October to your eldest child's teacher NOT the office. Family Photos will be taken at lunchtime in the Kindergarten Hall.
