Principal's Message

Staffing changes for 2019

Congratulations to Mrs Jeffrey who successfully applied via Expression of Interest to Relieve as Assistant Principal at Belmore North Public School for 2019. Mrs Jeffrey will commence work at Belmore North in Term 1 2019. At this stage we are just lending Mrs Jeffrey to Belmore North. Mrs Jeffrey still remains permanently appointed to Hurstville South. I know Mrs Jeffrey will be greatly missed in 2019.

AND Congratulations to Mrs Dimovska who has been appointed as the Permanent Assistant Principal at Oatley West Public School starting in 2019. Mrs Dimovska has been an integral part of the staff at Hurstville South Public School for 14 years and has made an outstanding contribution to our school in a range of roles including Relieving Assistant Principal, Reading Recovery teacher, classroom teacher and Learning and Support Teacher. I know Mrs Dimovska will be greatly missed by students, staff and parents. Although we would all love Mrs Dimovska to remain at Hurstville South Public School this is a fantastic leadership position and Mrs Dimovska is looking forward to this opportunity. We will be saying a fond farewell to Mrs Dimovska at the end of this year. No doubt there will be some tears of joy and sadness when Mrs Dimovska goes through the tunnel on the last day of school.

AND congratulations to Mr Fisher who was appointed as the Acting Deputy Principal at Peakhurst West and Penshurst Public School for 2019 and 2020. This is a two year role working for two schools. Penshurst Public School is relocating into a pop up school at Peakhurst West Public School while a new school is being built on the current site of Penshurst Public School. They are building a bigger multi-storey school to help manage the growing student numbers in the area. This is an outstanding leadership opportunity for Mr Fisher and his skills in technology and leadership have earnt him this promotion. Mr Fisher now has the unusual position of supporting to two Principals when he arrives at work every day! That is certainly a unique job description but I know the Principals Mr Fisher will be working with will make sure he has a great leadership experience. Mr Fisher still remains permanently appointed at Hurstville South Public School during this time.

In our next newsletter I will give you some information regarding any further staff changes for 2019 and I will take the opportunity to introduce some of the new staff members who will be joining our team.

Playground Update

It has been nice this week to see students playing in our new playground area. Now students have a bit more space to run and land a little more softly. This work has been paid by successful grant applications from the P & C, through P & C fundraising and through school funds.

We are all still adjusting to the new expectations surrounding the playground. Students are learning that they are not allowed to play in the "purple zone" in the morning. This has not changed.

At lunch and recess students are not allowed onto the "purple zone" until the teacher on duty arrives at the purple rubberised surface. Hurstville South Public School students can display self control and focus on teacher instructions so I know they will learn quickly to adjust to this change. The removal of the fence has created a more modern and integrated play space for all students.

During drop off and pick up at school no children should be in the purple zone. This equipment is designed to be used for students of school age and is not safe for smaller children. They cannot safely reach parts of the equipment and I would be concerned that they could be injured.

I would just remind parents that once you meet your children in the afternoon it is time to head home. We need to know that all children have left safely. Also, the playground is part of the area leased to our before and after school provider (Cubbyhouse) and they need to use the school grounds before and after school.

Brick Fair

A big thank you to all of our parents who worked so hard to make Brick Fair happen last weekend. It really is a huge effort and I know there were lots of exhausted parents on Sunday. I am sure quite a few were also very tired on Monday morning when they were heading off to work or getting children ready for school.

Our P & C are a small dedicated group of parents but the group certainly extended on the weekend with many parents helping out to make the day a huge success. Thank you to all the wonderful volunteers, I am truly grateful. I know that all of the funds raised will go directly into improving this amazing school so that your children can learn and play in the best place we can possibly provide.

The P & C executive have been working hard to plan this event since Term 1. A huge amount of effort goes into the background for a big event like the Brick Fair, from the booking of the displays to developing all of the promotion material and coordinating with the school. I feel very fortunate to have such a wonderful P & C executive to work with. I hope more parents come along and join us next year at our P & C Meetings.

Our students also had some fantastic work on display. The mini figs in KG were very creative, all of the photos and images developed by students and displayed in KV were outstanding and in the morning we had some students showing some robotics in action in the brick pit. Thank you to all of our students.

Thank you also to our teachers who volunteered their time to attend the Brick Fair on Sunday and many were also at the school disco a few weeks ago.

This weekend I think we have all earnt a good rest so that we are refreshed for all the end of year festivities like our Parent and Scripture Helpers thank you morning tea, Presentation Day and the Year 6 Farewell.


